## SB 425

This bill supports national efforts to reclassify Telecomunicators as first responders by declaring them first responders in the state of Oregon. This joins efforts with other state and local governments across the country who have passed legislation or resolutions declaring the same. On the Federal level, there is a bill in Congress that would reclassify them nationally from clerical staff to first responders.
