

Many part-time/adjunct faculty at Oregon's community colleges and public universities teach enough total hours that they should qualify for health care coverage under current requirements, but the mere fact that they teach at multiple institutions disallows them from coverage, even though their colleagues that teach the same amount (or less) at one institution receive coverage. The importance of health care coverage has never been more important and this unequitable situation makes it even harder to recruit and maintain highly qualified instructors to teach in Oregon.
