## Measure: SB 439

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### SUMMARY

Requires insurer offering health plan, or person acting on behalf of insurer, to reduce enrollee cost sharing for prescription drugs by 85 percent of rebates received by insurer.

### OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure the amount of rebates or a reasonable estimate of rebates received or to be received by an insurer for a prescription drug from a manufacturer, pharmacy or other entity in connection with the dispensing or administering of the drug.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, prescription drug rebates could be made public.
