SUMMARY

Directs Department of Corrections and local correctional facilities to assess and address health care needs of persons in custody upon intake. Establishes standards for provision of health care to persons in custody. Requires that person in custody receive copy of medical records upon release.

Establishes health navigator positions for employment within Department of Corrections and local correctional facilities. Provides that health navigator salaries are paid by Oregon Health Authority. Appropriates moneys to authority to fund positions.

Directs Department of Corrections and cities and counties operating local correctional facilities to report to Legislative Assembly each biennium concerning health outcomes of persons in custody.
