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SUMMARY

Requires individual and group health insurance policies, health care service contractors, multiple employer welfare arrangements and state medical assistance program to provide reimbursement for at least three primary care visits annually.

Prohibits individual and group health insurance policies, health care service contractors, multiple employer welfare arrangements and state medical assistance program from denying coverage for services provided by behavioral health home and patient centered primary care home because services were provided on same day or in same facility. Prohibits individual and group health insurance policies, health care services contractors and multiple employer welfare arrangements from imposing more than single copayment for services provided by behavioral health home and patient centered primary care home on same day.

Prohibits individual and group health insurance policies, health care service contractors, multiple employer welfare arrangements and state medical assistance program from requiring prior authorization for specialty behavioral health services provided at behavioral health home or patient centered primary care home.
