Measure Description:

Directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct needs assessment identifying current mental health provider education programs and curricula offered at community colleges and public universities.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Behavioral Health to the House Committee on Education.

The measure directs Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC) to conduct needs assessment identifying mental health education offered at higher education campuses and submit its report to the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Higher Education Coordinating Commission.
