Measure Description:

Modifies protective proceedings to permit vulnerable youth guardianships for adults between 18 and 21 years of age who are eligible for special immigrant status and who are unable to be reunified with parent due to abuse, neglect or abandonment that occurred before adult attained 18 years of age.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Health Authority (OHA), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA), Public Defense Service Commission (PDSC), Department of Justice (DOJ)

Analysis:

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
