SUMMARY

Prohibits court from allowing public display or public disclosure of images of person in state of nudity, except pursuant to court order entered after showing of good cause.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure exempts from public disclosure images of a person in a state of nudity that are part of the record in a court proceeding except pursuant to a court order entered after a showing of good cause.

If those public records that could be subject to public disclosure were instead subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law, the public could receive images of a person in a state of nudity that are part of the record in a court proceeding.
