WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Provides statutory parameters for voluntary supported decision-making agreements.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Need to refer HB 2105 to the House Human Services Committee

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

A supported decision-making agreement is an agreement made between two or more persons in which one person agrees to help the other with tasks like gathering documents, understanding the consequences of a decision, and communicating decisions. These agreements are becoming popular as an alternative to guardianship.

House Bill 2105 provides statutory parameters for use of supported decision-making agreements.
