Measure Description:

Removes certain nonviolent crimes from list of crimes that automatically make person ineligible to hold license or registration issued by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission if person has been convicted of crime.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Education (ODE), Department of Justice (DOJ), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Teacher Standards and Practices Commission (TSPC)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Judiciary to the House Committee on Education.

The measure removes certain nonviolent crimes from list of crimes that automatically make person ineligible to hold license or registration issued by Teacher Standards and Practices Commission if person has been convicted of crime.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Department of Education, Department of Justice, District Attorneys, Oregon Judicial Department, Public Defense Services Commission, and the Teachers Standards and Practices Commission.
