Measure Description:

Extends privilege taxes on merchantable forest products harvested on forestlands.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Forestry (ODF), Department of Revenue (DOR), Department of Land Conservation and Development (DLCD), Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC), Counties, Department of State Lands (DSL), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources to the House Committee on Revenue

The measure extends privilege taxes on merchantable forest products.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on Department of Revenue, Department of State Lands, Oregon Judicial Department, Department of Forestry, Department of Land Conservation and Development, Higher Education Coordinating Commission and Counties.
