WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes Task Force on Education Pathways. Prescribes membership and duties. Sunsets task force on December 31, 2022. Takes effect 91st day following adjournment sine die.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Needs of students
- Value to state of providing a variety of educational options to students

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Reduces the number of members of the task force. Removes career and technical education from task force study. Allows task force to establish advisory and technical committees.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon's education system comprises a variety of educational options for students, including neighborhood schools, charter schools, alternative schools and programs, youth corrections and juvenile detention education programs, virtual schools and programs, and virtual charter schools.

House Bill 3236 A establishes a legislative task force to review the adequacy and effectiveness of education pathways in the state.
