Measure Description:

Directs the Secretary of State to publish on the secretary's website a list of the top five most commonly spoken languages, other than English, in the State of Oregon. Requires a landlord of a manufactured dwelling park to notify an existing or prospective tenant, or a prospective purchaser, that, upon request, a rental agreement and an application for occupancy will be provided by the landlord in any of the top five languages, other than English, that are most commonly spoken in the state.

Analysis:
