WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Specifically allows Department of Public Safety Standards and Training to procure goods and services. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Current procurement process for Department of Public Safety Standards and Training through Department of Administrative Services
- Charge and goals of Department of Public Safety Standards and Training
- Provisions of measure

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

The Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST) is responsible for certifying and training public safety personnel in the state of Oregon. Currently, Oregon law allows DPSST to contract or cooperate with any person or agency of government for procurement of services or property.

Senate Bill 115 gives DPSST specific authority to procure goods or services in furtherance of its charge.
