**Measure Description:**

Authorizes State Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision to discharge person from parole or post-prison supervision prior to end of supervision term for specified medical reason if compatible with best interests of person and community.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Corrections (DOC), Criminal Justice Commission (CJC), Board of Parole and Post-Prison Supervision (BPPPS)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
