**Measure Description:**

Authorizes Housing and Community Services Department to grant moneys to nonprofit organization for community pilot programs that develop accessory dwelling units for income-eligible homeowners and that are available for lease by income-eligible tenants.

**Analysis:**

HB 3335 A-Engrossed appropriates \$1,000,000 to the Housing and Community Services Department (HCSD) to award a grant to the Hacienda Community Development Corporation to fund an accessory dwelling unit (ADU) community pilot program. The measure requires HCSD to report on the program to the Legislative Assembly by September 15, 2023.

HCSD will use existing staff and resources to review the proposal and develop a grant award to ensure compliance with the requirements of the measure, review reports, monitor the project, and conduct periodic audits, as well as to report to the Legislative Assembly.

This measure is referred to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means by prior reference.
