**Measure Description:**

Repeals statute authorizing law enforcement officers to command dispersal of unlawful assemblies and arrest participants who do not disperse.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Department of Public Safety Standards and Training (DPSST), Oregon Military Department (OMD), Oregon State Police (OSP), Counties, Cities, Oregon State Sheriffs' Association(OSSA)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
