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Measure Description:

Authorizes licensed nurse to discuss medical use of marijuana with person with whom the nurse has a patient-provider relationship. Authorizes health care providers to issue written documentation required of registry cardholder applications. Defines “provider” as physician, physician assistant, nurse practitioner, clinical nurse specialist, certified registered nurse anesthetist, and naturopathic physician. Prohibits the Oregon Board of Naturopathic Medicine, Oregon Medical Board, and Oregon State Board of Nursing from imposing civil penalties or taking disciplinary action on provider for advising on medical use of marijuana or issuing written documentation required of registry cardholder applications.
