Analysis:

House Bill 2847 appropriates funds to the Oregon Military Department (OMD) to study options for improvements to the Oregon National Guard's Service Member and Family Support Program. The measure directs OMD to report on their findings and make recommendations to the Legislative Assembly by January 1, 2023. The measure takes effect July 1, 2021.

Under this measure, OMD would receive \$791,680 General Fund to fund four additional Program Analyst 2 positions in the Service Member and Family Support Program.

This measure warrants subsequent referral to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means as it requires budgetary action for the appropriation of General Fund resources and position establishment.
