Measure Description:

Allows the Construction Contractors Board to establish a voluntary certification program for a residential master builder of vertical homeownership structures and other structures, which, at a minimum, must provide education, training, assessment, and evaluation of an individual’s knowledge of and skills in aspects of residential construction identified by statute. Allows the board to adopt rules to implement the certification program, including any fees that are necessary to pay the expenses of administering the program.
