Measure Description:

Requires State Forestry Department to study and make recommendations to interim committee of Legislative Assembly regarding wildfire prevention.

Analysis: The measure directs the Oregon Department of Forestry (ODF) to establish a pilot grant program for the purpose of managing wildfire risk. The measure outlines methods and directs ODF to develop criteria for receiving grants, the process for applying for grants, and the reporting requirements after receiving grants.

The measure appropriates \$1.0 million General Fund to ODF for the purposes of the bill. ODF anticipates managing the grants with existing resources.
