Measure Description:

Provides that the county clerk in every county shall establish regular business hours of at least four hours per day, and 30 hours per work week, for receipt and certification of instruments presented for recording. Allows the county clerk to reduce the number of regular business hours below four hours per day and 30 hours per week under specified circumstances.
