Measure Description:

Requires the Director of the Department of Consumer and Business Services to amend the state building code to require that new construction of certain buildings include provisions for electrical service capacity for specified percentage of parking spaces. Authorizes municipalities, by process concerning land use, to require that each newly constructed building include provisions for electrical service capacity to accommodate more than 20 percent of vehicle parking spaces in the garage or parking area for the building.
