**Measure Description:**

Allows a physician assistant to register with the Oregon Medical Board for authority to dispense prescription drugs. Specifies requirements for dispensation by a physician assistant. Allows the board to license an out-of-state physician assistant to practice medicine in Oregon. Resolves potential conflicts with House Bill 2078 (2021).

**Analysis:**
