WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Establishes Tribal Early Learning Hub to coordinate early learning services for tribal communities, distinct from regional Hubs established in ORS 417.827. Establishes Tribal advisory committee.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

Oregon currently has 16 regional early learning hubs to coordinate local systems for the delivery of early learning in their regions. House Bill 2055 establishes a Tribal Early Learning Hub, specifically to serve Oregon's tribal communities.
