Measure Description:

Includes "fortified cider" in definition of "cider." Allows the holder of a winery license to purchase from the Oregon Liquor Control Commission distilled liquors for fortifying cider. Allows Oregon counties to possess a liquor license. Removes the authority of the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to assess an application fee for new alcohol licenses or applications to change location or ownership. Authorizes the Oregon Liquor Control Commission to allow an applicant to defer or waive license payments if the Governor declares a state of emergency. Repeals Section 4 of Enrolled Senate Bill 317 (2021).
