

House Bill 2085

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Oregon Health Authority)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Oregon Health Authority to explore and report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health viable options for addressing shortfalls in funding for medical assistance.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to health care finance.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Oregon Health Authority shall explore options for addressing shortfalls**
5 **in funding for the state medical assistance program. No later than September 15, 2022, the**
6 **authority shall report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to**
7 **health, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the authority's findings and recommendations**
8 **for legislative changes necessary to address the funding shortfalls.**
