CHAPTER

AN ACT

Relating to programs administered by the Department of Human Services; and declaring an emergency.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

<u>SECTION 1.</u> No later than December 31, 2022, the Department of Human Services shall report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to human services a comprehensive proposal for department staffing that is adaptable to achieve customer service obligations, program outcomes and policy goals.

<u>SECTION 2.</u> This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.
