

SENATE AMENDMENTS TO RESOLVE CONFLICTS TO HOUSE BILL 2111

1 On page 49 of the printed bill, after line 11, insert:

2 “SECTION 44a. If House Bill 2264 becomes law, section 44 of this 2021 Act (amending ORS
3 471.130) is repealed and ORS 471.130, as amended by section 5, chapter __, Oregon Laws 2021
4 (Enrolled House Bill 2264), is amended to read:

5 “471.130. (1) Before selling or serving an alcoholic beverage to any person about whom there is
6 any reasonable doubt of the person’s having reached 21 years of age, a licensee or permittee shall
7 require the person to produce one of the following pieces of identification:

8 “(a) The person’s passport issued by the United States or a foreign government.

9 “(b) The person’s motor vehicle operator’s license issued by this state or another state of the
10 United States or a province or territory of Canada.

11 “(c) An identification card issued under ORS 807.400.

12 “(d) A United States military identification card.

13 “(e) An identification card issued by a federally recognized Indian tribe.

14 “(f) Any other identification card issued by a state or territory of the United States or province
15 or territory of Canada that bears a picture of the person, the name of the person, the person’s date
16 of birth and a physical description of the person.

17 “(g) Proof of the person’s participation in the Secure Electronic Network for Travelers Rapid
18 Inspection program operated by United States Customs and Border Protection, the NEXUS program
19 jointly operated by that agency and the Canada Border Services Agency, or a successor to either
20 of those programs that is recognized by the [*Oregon Liquor Control Commission*] **Oregon Liquor
21 and Cannabis Commission.**

22 “(h) Any other form of identification as defined by the commission by rule.

23 “(2) If a person does not have identification as described in subsection (1) of this section, the
24 permittee or licensee shall require the person to make a written statement of age and furnish evi-
25 dence of the person’s true age and identity. The written statement of age shall be on a form fur-
26 nished or approved by the commission, including but not limited to the following information:

14 "**SECTION 108a. If House Bill 2264 becomes law, section 108 of this 2021 Act (amending**
15 **ORS 471.478) is repealed.**".
