

House Bill 2141

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Department of Veterans' Affairs)

SUMMARY

Extends duration of Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to the Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program; amending sections 6 and 8, chapter 527,
3 Oregon Laws 2019.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** Section 6, chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to read:

6 **Sec. 6.** (1) Sections 1 and 2 [*of this 2019 Act*], **chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019**, are repealed
7 on January 2, [2022] **2024**.

8 (2) Any moneys remaining in the Veteran Educational Bridge Grant Program Fund established
9 under section 2 [*of this 2019 Act*], **chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019**, on [January 2, 2022] **the date**
10 **specified in subsection (1) of this section**, after reversion of unspent lottery allocations to the
11 Veterans' Service Fund established under ORS 406.140, shall be transferred to the Veterans' Edu-
12 cational Aid Account established under ORS 408.090.

13 **SECTION 2.** Section 8, chapter 527, Oregon Laws 2019, is amended to read:

14 **Sec. 8.** The amendments to ORS 408.090 by section 7 [*of this 2019 Act*], **chapter 527, Oregon**
15 **Laws 2019**, become operative on [January 2, 2022] **the date specified in section 6, chapter 527,**
16 **Oregon Laws 2019**.
