

House Bill 2147

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Higher Education Coordinating Commission)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Higher Education Coordinating Commission to conduct study and develop recommendations on how Oregon's public post-secondary institutions of education can best deliver, in equitable manner, high quality education during periods of economic recession.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

1
2 Relating to higher education; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Higher Education Coordinating Commission shall conduct a study**
5 **and develop recommendations on how Oregon's public post-secondary institutions of educa-**
6 **tion can best deliver, in an equitable manner, high quality education to students during pe-**
7 **riods of economic recession. The study must include an analysis of the best potential use of**
8 **online education.**

9 **(2) The commission shall submit a report detailing the recommendations developed under**
10 **subsection (1) of this section to the legislative committees responsible for higher education**
11 **during the 2022 regular session of the Legislative Assembly.**

12 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on June 30, 2022.**

13 **SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021**
14 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
