

House Bill 2167

Introduced and printed pursuant to House Rule 12.00. Pre-session filed (at the request of Governor Kate Brown for Office of the Governor)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Office of Governor to study and make recommendations regarding certain proposals relating to state boards and commissions. Requires office to submit report on findings by January 1, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to state entities.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Office of the Governor shall study and make recommendations re-**
5 **garding the following proposals relating to state boards and commissions, excluding**
6 **workgroups, task forces and other temporary bodies:**

7 (a) **The payment of a per diem to members;**

8 (b) **The provision of language access services and reimbursement for childcare during**
9 **meetings; and**

10 (c) **If statutory membership requirements prevent an appointing authority from ap-**
11 **pointing members representing the diversity of Oregonians, permitting the appointing au-**
12 **thority to disregard statutory membership requirements to the extent necessary to appoint**
13 **members representing all Oregonians.**

14 (2) **The office shall submit a report on its findings to an appropriate committee of the**
15 **Legislative Assembly no later than January 1, 2023.**

16 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**
