

House Bill 2206

Sponsored by Representative WILDE (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Permits party to domestic relations proceeding to use party's initials as party's designation.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to domestic relations proceedings.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. In a proceeding under the provisions of ORS chapter 107, 108, 109 or 110, a party to the proceeding may request to use the initials of the party's true name as the party's designation. To make the request, the party shall file with the clerk of the court a written request and at the same time a separate declaration containing the party's true name and corresponding initials. Upon receiving the written request and declaration, the court shall grant the request and use the initials of the party's true name as the party's designation.

NOTE: Matter in **boldfaced** type in an amended section is new; matter [*italic and bracketed*] is existing law to be omitted. New sections are in **boldfaced** type.
