2 Relating to domestic relations proceedings.

3 Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

4 <u>SECTION 1.</u> In a proceeding under the provisions of ORS chapter 107, 108, 109 or 110, a

5 party to the proceeding may request to use the initials of the party's true name as the

6 party's designation. To make the request, the party shall file with the clerk of the court a

7 written request and at the same time a separate declaration containing the party's true

8 name and corresponding initials. Upon receiving the written request and declaration, the

9 court shall grant the request and use the initials of the party's true name as the party's
10 designation.
