SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Imposes requirements on [*appointing authority that employs person in state service*] **state agency that employs person** at rate higher than rate for executives under compensation plan for state employees.

2 Relating to employment in state service.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section:**

5 (a) **"State agency" means any state officer, board, commission, corporation, institution,**
6 **department or other state organization in the executive or legislative department, as defined**
7 **in ORS 174.112 and 174.114.**

8 (b) **Notwithstanding ORS 182.460, 284.118, 284.375, 377.836, 421.352 and 757.552, "state**
9 **agency" includes semi-independent state agencies listed in ORS 182.454, the Oregon Tourism**
10 **Commission, the Oregon Film and Video Office, the Travel Information Council, the**
11 **Children's Trust Fund of Oregon Foundation, Oregon Corrections Enterprises and the**
12 **Oregon Utility Notification Center.**

13 (c) **"State agency" includes a public university listed in ORS 352.002.**

14 (2) **A state agency may not employ a person at a rate of pay higher than the rate for**
15 **executives under the compensation plan for state employees unless the state agency makes**
16 **available to the public an explanation of how the rate is appropriate and in the public inter-**
17 **est.**

18 (3)(a) **A state agency subject to ORS chapter 240 shall report biennially to the Oregon**
19 **Department of Administrative Services on persons employed under this section.**

20 (b) **A state agency not subject to ORS chapter 240 shall report biennially to an appropri-**
21 **ate committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly on persons employed under**
22 **this section.**
