## House Bill 2221

Sponsored by Representative WILDE (Presession filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Imposes requirements on appointing authority that employs person in state service at rate higher than rate for executives under compensation plan for state employees.

A BILL FOR AN ACT
Relating to employment in state service.
Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 240.
SECTION 2. (1) An appointing authority may not employ a person in state service at a
rate higher than the rate for executives under the compensation plan for state employees
unless the appointing authority makes available to the public:
(a) An expert opinion regarding the range of pay appropriate for the person's position;
and
(b) An explanation of how the rate of pay:
(A) Is appropriate and in the public interest; or
(B) Will not result in General Fund expenditures.
(2) The Oregon Department of Administrative Services may adopt rules to implement this
section.
SECTION 3. Section 2 of this 2021 Act applies to persons in the employment of state
service on and after the effective date of this 2021 Act.
