

# House Bill 2263

Sponsored by Representative LIVELY (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Oregon Liquor Control Commission to study recreational marijuana tracking. Requires report to interim committee of Legislative Assembly related to economic development.  
Sunsets January 2, 2022.  
Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to recreational marijuana tracking; and declaring an emergency.

**Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

**SECTION 1. The Oregon Liquor Control Commission shall study the recreational marijuana tracking system and recreational marijuana tracking requirements in this state.**

**The commission shall report its findings and recommendations to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to economic development no later than December 31, 2021.**

**SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2022.**

**SECTION 3. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect on its passage.**
