

# House Bill 2336

Sponsored by Representative MARSH, Senator GELSER (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Consumer and Business Services to establish by rule appendix in Oregon residential specialty code based upon visitability standards for Type C Units provided by American National Standards Institute.

Declares emergency, effective on passage.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to residential housing; and declaring an emergency.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 455.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) The Department of Consumer and Business Services shall establish by**  
6 **rule an appendix to the Oregon residential specialty code consistent with and based upon the**  
7 **American National Standards Institute standards for Type C Units in section 1005 of A117.1**  
8 **(2009).**

9 **(2) The appendix described under subsection (1) of this section shall be designed in a**  
10 **manner that facilitates adoption by local jurisdictions.**

11 **SECTION 3. (1) Section 2 of this 2021 Act becomes operative on October 31, 2021.**

12 **(2) The Department of Consumer and Business Services may take any action before the**  
13 **operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for the department**  
14 **to exercise on and after the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of**  
15 **the duties, functions and powers conferred on the department by section 2 of this 2021 Act.**

16 **SECTION 4. This 2021 Act being necessary for the immediate preservation of the public**  
17 **peace, health and safety, an emergency is declared to exist, and this 2021 Act takes effect**  
18 **on its passage.**
