

House Bill 2405

Sponsored by Representative NERON (Pre-session filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Corrections to study challenges to providing dietary accommodations to individuals with special dietary needs who are incarcerated in department correctional facilities. Requires department to report findings from study, and recommendations to address challenges, to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to education.

Sunset on January 2, 2023.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

Relating to dietary accommodations for incarcerated individuals.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. The Department of Corrections shall study the challenges related to providing dietary accommodations to individuals with special dietary needs who are incarcerated in department correctional facilities. No later than September 15, 2022, the department shall report to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to the judiciary, in the manner provided in ORS 192.245, the findings of the study and recommendations for legislative changes to address such challenges.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
