Requires district attorney to, upon request, provide to sexual assault victim opportunity to review case file within district attorney's office.

3	Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:
4	SECTION 1. (1) Upon request, a district attorney shall provide to a sexual assault victim
5	the opportunity to review, within the office of the district attorney, the contents of the dis-
6	trict attorney's case file concerning the sexual assault.
7	(2) As used in this section, "sexual assault victim" means a person named as the alleged
8	victim in an accusatory instrument charging a crime described in ORS 163.355 to 163.427.
