SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure.

Provides that juror may not be identified by name in court proceeding open to public. Directs court to ensure that parties have access to names of jurors **unless court determines that there is good cause to order otherwise.**

2 Relating to jurors.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS chapter 10.**

5 **SECTION 2. (1) A juror may not be identified by name in any court proceeding open to**
6 **the public.**

7 **(2) Notwithstanding subsection (1) of this section, a court shall ensure that the names**
8 **of jurors are available to the parties to a proceeding unless the court determines that there**
9 **is good cause to order otherwise.**
