

House Bill 2702

Sponsored by Representative ZIKA; Representatives BREESE-IVERSON, LEIF, SMITH DB (Presession filed.)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires school districts to ensure that students in grade 12 receive instructional program on home ownership. Directs Department of Education to prepare materials to assist school districts in providing program.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to instructional program on home ownership.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) Each school district shall ensure that students in grade 12 receive an**
5 **instructional program on home ownership. The instructional program must be at least one**
6 **hour.**

7 **(2) The Department of Education shall consult with the Real Estate Commission to pre-**
8 **pare materials to assist school districts in providing an instructional program on home**
9 **ownership.**

10 **(3) An instructional program on home ownership may be provided by a licensed teacher,**
11 **a person licensed by the Real Estate Commissioner or a representative of a financial insti-**
12 **tution.**

13 **SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2021 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2022.**

14 **(2) Section 1 of this 2021 Act first applies to the 2022-2023 school year.**

15 **(3) Notwithstanding the operative date set forth in subsection (1) of this section, the**
16 **Department of Education may take any action before the operative date set forth in sub-**
17 **section (1) of this section that is necessary for school districts to comply with the require-**
18 **ments of section 1 of this 2021 Act.**
