

HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO HOUSE BILL 2746

1 Delete lines 4 through 27 of the printed bill and insert:

2 **“SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Justice shall develop, implement and administer a**
3 **statewide Hope Card Program for the issuance of information cards regarding eligible civil**
4 **protection orders.**

5 **“(2) The department, by rule, shall establish eligibility requirements for eligible civil**
6 **protection orders.**

7 **“(3) Upon request, the Hope Card Program shall provide one or more information cards**
8 **to a person protected by an eligible civil protection order.**

9 **“(4) An information card issued under this section must be a durable, wallet-sized card**
10 **containing essential information about the civil protection order, including the persons sub-**
11 **ject to the order, the court case number and jurisdiction, the issuance and expiration dates**
12 **of the order and any other information prescribed by the department by rule.**

13 **“(5) The Hope Card Program may not charge a fee for an application for or the issuance**
14 **of an information card under this section.**

15 **“(6) The department, in consultation with Oregon Indian tribes, the Oregon State Police,**
16 **the State Court Administrator, representatives of victim service organizations and other**
17 **appropriate entities, shall adopt rules for the administration of the Hope Card Program.**

18 **“SECTION 2. (1) Section 1 of this 2021 Act becomes operative on July 1, 2022.**

19 **“(2) The Department of Justice may take any action before the operative date specified**
20 **in subsection (1) of this section that is necessary for the department to exercise, on or after**
21 **the operative date specified in subsection (1) of this section, all of the duties, functions and**
22 **powers conferred on the department by section 1 of this 2021 Act.”.**
