

# House Bill 2906

Sponsored by Representative EVANS (Pre-session filed.)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Public Employees Retirement Board to study methods for allowing members of Public Employees Retirement System to certify that member will earn less than \$30,000 in calendar year so that board does not credit employee contributions to employee pension stability account.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to employee contributions to the Public Employees Retirement System.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. The Public Employees Retirement Board shall study methods for allowing**  
5 **members of the Public Employees Retirement System to certify that the member will earn**  
6 **less than \$30,000 in a calendar year so that the board credits all employee contributions made**  
7 **by the member under ORS 238A.330 to the employee account established for the member**  
8 **under ORS 238A.350 (2). The board shall report on the results of the study to an appropriate**  
9 **committee or interim committee of the Legislative Assembly no later than September 15,**  
10 **2022.**

11 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**
