

House Bill 3054

Sponsored by JOINT COMMITTEE ON TRANSPORTATION (at the request of Representative Susan McLain, Senator Lee Beyer)

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Requires Department of Transportation to study and make recommendations on provisions of state law relating to public transportation.

Sunsets January 2, 2023.

Relating to public transportation.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Transportation shall study and make recommendations on provisions of state law relating to public transportation.

(2) The department shall submit the report required by subsection (1) of this section, and may include recommendations for legislation, to the interim committees of the Legislative Assembly related to transportation in the manner provided under ORS 192.245 no later than September 15, 2022.

SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.
