

House Bill 3058

Sponsored by Representatives SCHOUTEN, HELM; Representatives DEXTER, PRUSAK, SALINAS, Senators DEMBROW, TAYLOR

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Increases distance from certain parts of public places and places of employment in which person may not smoke, aerosolize or vaporize from 10 feet to 25 feet.

4 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

5 **SECTION 1.** ORS 433.845 is amended to read:

6 433.845. (1) A person may not smoke, aerosolize or vaporize an inhalant or carry a lighted
7 smoking instrument in a public place or place of employment except as provided in ORS 433.850.

8 (2) A person may not smoke, aerosolize or vaporize an inhalant or carry a lighted smoking in-
9 strument within [10] **25** feet of the following parts of public places or places of employment:

10 (a) Entrances;

11 (b) Exits;

12 (c) Windows that open; and

13 (d) Ventilation intakes that serve an enclosed area.

14 (3) A person may not smoke, aerosolize or vaporize an inhalant or carry a lighted smoking in-
15 strument in a room during the time that jurors are required to use the room.
