

# House Bill 3093

Sponsored by COMMITTEE ON WATER (at the request of Representative Ken Helm)

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Directs Department of Environmental Quality to study harmful algal blooms and provide results of study in report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly no later than September 15, 2022.  
Sunsets January 2, 2023.  
Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

1  
2 Relating to harmful algal blooms; and prescribing an effective date.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) The Department of Environmental Quality shall study harmful algal**  
5 **blooms and make recommendations for legislation.**

6 **(2) The department shall provide the results of the study and recommendations in a re-**  
7 **port to the appropriate interim committees of the Legislative Assembly, in the manner pro-**  
8 **vided in ORS 192.245, no later than September 15, 2022.**

9 **SECTION 2. Section 1 of this 2021 Act is repealed on January 2, 2023.**

10 **SECTION 3. This 2021 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the date on which the 2021**  
11 **regular session of the Eighty-first Legislative Assembly adjourns sine die.**
