

House Bill 3174

Sponsored by Representative SMITH DB

SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Prohibits court from allowing public display or public disclosure of images of person in state of nudity, except pursuant to court order entered after showing of good cause.

A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to images of person in state of nudity.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. (1) As used in this section, "nudity" has the meaning given that term in ORS**
5 **30.831.**

6 **(2) A court of this state may not publicly display images of a person in a state of nudity**
7 **except pursuant to a court order entered after a showing of good cause.**

8 **(3) Images of a person in a state of nudity that are part of the record in a court pro-**
9 **ceeding shall be subject to inspection only by the parties to the proceedings and their attor-**
10 **neys, and may not be subject to inspection by members of the public except pursuant to a**
11 **court order entered after a showing of good cause.**
