

# House Bill 3252

Sponsored by Representative SMITH DB

## SUMMARY

The following summary is not prepared by the sponsors of the measure and is not a part of the body thereof subject to consideration by the Legislative Assembly. It is an editor's brief statement of the essential features of the measure **as introduced**.

Allows Governor to enter into agreement with another state to allow for transportation of marijuana items to and from this state through other state.

## A BILL FOR AN ACT

2 Relating to interstate transportation of marijuana items.

3 **Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:**

4 **SECTION 1. Section 2 of this 2021 Act is added to and made a part of ORS 475B.010 to**  
5 **475B.545.**

6 **SECTION 2. (1) The Governor may enter into an agreement with another state for the**  
7 **purpose of coordinating the transportation of marijuana items to and from this state through**  
8 **the other state.**

9 **(2) An agreement entered into under this section:**

10 **(a) Must ensure enforceable public health and safety standards, including a system to**  
11 **regulate and track the interstate transport of marijuana items;**

12 **(b) May provide for consideration to the other state; and**

13 **(c) May authorize one or more agencies of this state to provide policy recommendations**  
14 **and assist in the implementation and enforcement of the terms of the agreement.**

15 **(3) Notwithstanding ORS 475B.227 and in accordance with an agreement entered into**  
16 **under subsection (1) of this section, a marijuana producer licensed under ORS 475B.070, a**  
17 **marijuana wholesaler licensed under ORS 475B.100 or a marijuana retailer licensed under**  
18 **ORS 475B.105 may export, as that term is defined in ORS 475B.227, a marijuana item.**
