

House Bill 3326

SUMMARY

Prohibits local governments from charging fee to review application for mural and limits grounds for application denial.

Relating to murals.

Be It Enacted by the People of the State of Oregon:

SECTION 1. (1) A local government, as defined in ORS 197.015, may not charge a fee to review an application to install a mural on a building by the building's owner.

(2) As used in this section, "mural" means a painting or other artwork affixed to the side of the building that is not for commercial or political campaign purposes.
